Dutch municipalities are the largest public-sector organization in the Netherlands



342 Dutch municipalities (345 *incl. the BES/Cariben*)

170.000 Civil Servants

Every municipality approximately runs
400 – 500 Software applications (> 75% SaaS)

90 – 95% Is provided through market parties

Annual combined IT spendings > 2 billion euro
