Average number of attacks per day:

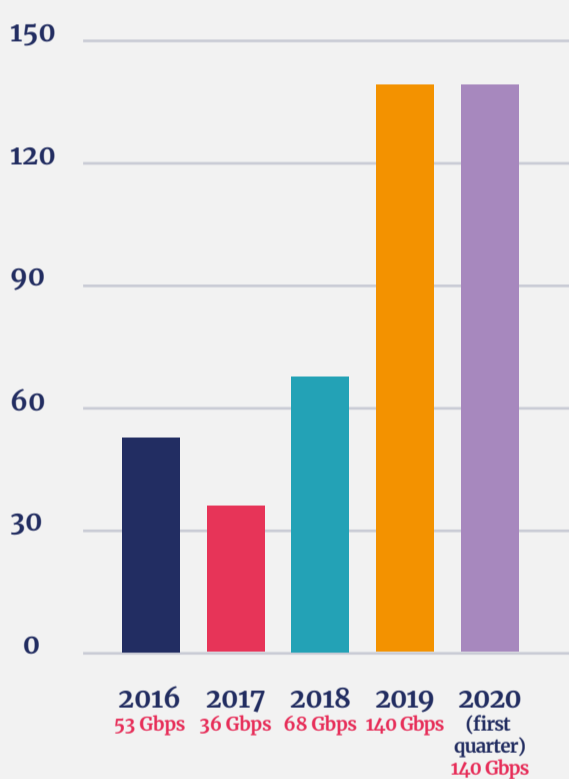

140 Gbps

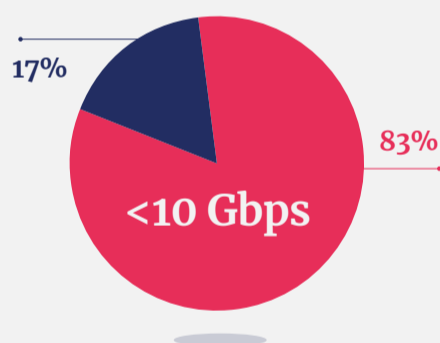
Maximum size of attacks

Attacks are becoming **more complex** but the majority is **smaller** than 10 Gbps in the first quarter of 2020

Attacks keep becoming more complex



Less attacks were registered in Q1 2020 compared to Q1 2019



During the first 3 months of 2020, there have been as many large scale attacks (40Gbps+) as in the whole of 2019

Most common type of attack: **DNS Amplification**
