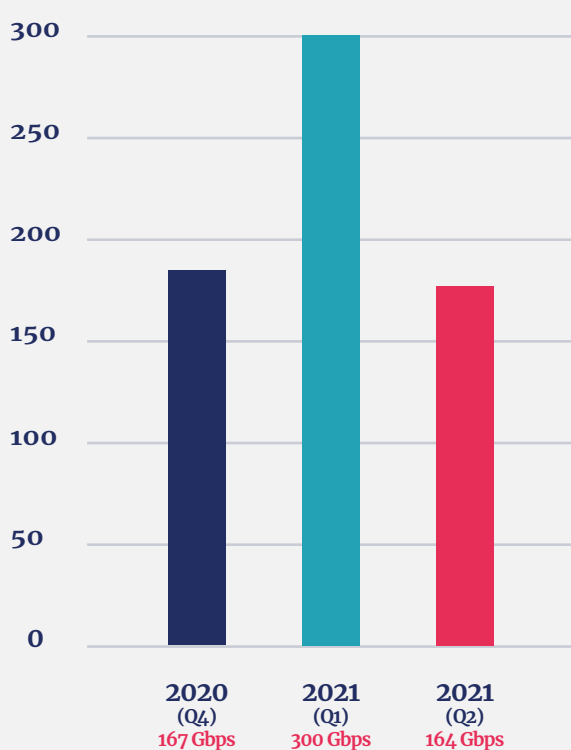

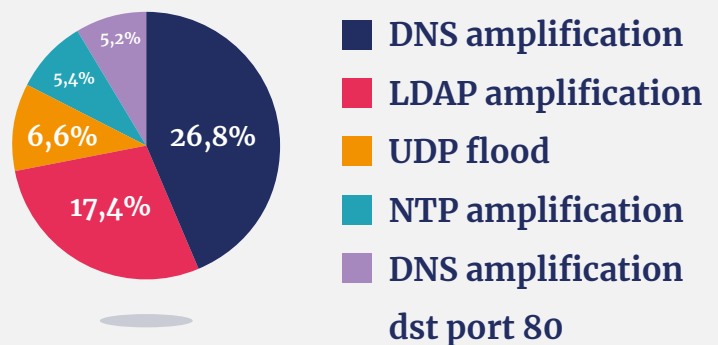

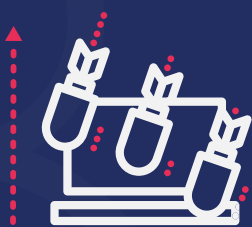

Trends



Fewer attacks than Q1 2021, but more than Q4 2020



Increase in smaller attacks



Fewer attacks per bps, compared to Q1 2021

Most common type of attacks: **DNS amplification & LDAP amplification**
Fewer attacks in Q2, but the number remains **high** compared to Q4 2020
